Navigating strategic leadership in special schools by providing ongoing training, educational updates and a support network

COURSE AIMS

- 1 To create a network of special/AP school leaders.
- 2 To provide a supportive, reflective space so that leadership and school provision can be developed without distraction.
- 3 To develop and use coaching skills to strengthen support within the new network.
- 4 To provide specialist input to address key current issues of leadership and running a special /AP school. All sessions will include updates on the latest educational policy requirements as well as the knowledge and skills required to keep educational and leadership practice current.
- 5 To raise awareness of relevant educational and leadership research and how this can be used to further develop the school.
